Our records indicate that your child is of an appropriate age to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that “The Lord Jesus Christ, physician of our souls and bodies, who forgave the sins of the paralytic and restored him to bodily health, has willed that His Church continue, in the power of the Holy Spirit, his work of healing and salvation, even among her own members.” The Sacrament of Reconciliation, as one of these sacraments of healing, is a great gift to us.

There will be a **required** initial meeting for parents of all students who have been baptized but have not received the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist on the following dates:

**Sunday, October 5 at 10:40 a.m.**

Or

**Wednesday, October 8 at 6:40 p.m.**

**Meeting held in the Activity Center on the Woodland Hills Campus**

Please plan to attend **one** of these meetings. The meeting will last approximately 1-1 ½ hour and will give you the opportunity to enroll your child in the sacramental preparation process. Students must be enrolled in St. Martha Catechesis (CCE) or Catholic School with 75% attendance; be in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or older; baptized; have attended formal catechesis (CCE) or Catholic School last year and the family has made a commitment to attend Catholic Mass on Sundays. **If your child attended classes somewhere other than St. Martha’s last year**, a letter of attendance must be provided. Please contact me if you have eligibility questions.

**Please bring a copy of your child’s baptismal certificate to the meeting. A \$20 sacramental fee will be collected at this time.** This fee covers the cost of the textbook, certificate, and supplemental materials made available to you.
